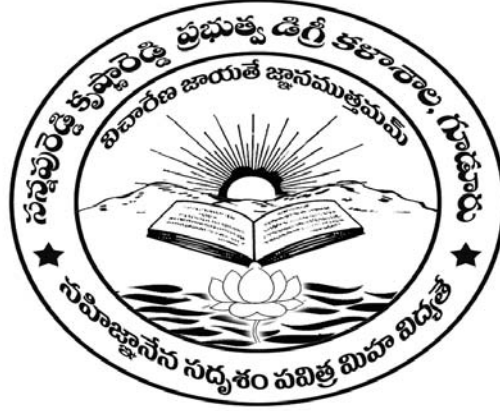

## **POST ACCREDITATION INITIATIVES**

With reference to the draft report on institutional accreditation of SKR Govt. Degree College, Gudur, SPSR Nellore Dt., Andhra Pradesh, (visit dates 28<sup>th</sup> & 29<sup>th</sup> March, 2007), the following post accreditation initiatives have been adopted.

1. Feed back on teaching learning process is procured from the students. These feed back forms are deposited with the Principal, and submitted to the academic audit team. Feed back is provided to the Lecturers for their self improvement.
2. A time bound master plan for physical expansion of the institution is guided by the Commissionerate of Collegiate Education from time to time. Proposals are submitted as and when required by the authorities.

With reference to academic curriculam, departmental and institutional plans are prepared annually and implemented.

3. M.Sc course in Microbiology was started, but want of admissions and allotment at the time of counseling by the University, the course is not run at present.
4. Library automation is in progress. SOUL software has been installed. OPAC is also available. Reprographic machinery is made available for the use of students and staff.
5. 22 desktop computers are purchased from UGC XI Plan funds. 14 more desktop computers are purchased from UGC XII Plan funds. Each and every department has been provided with a computer. Printers are also made available in some departments, and they are shared to meet the requirements of other departments as well. Efforts are on to provide a printer and scanner to each department.

JKC lab has been established. JKC ( Jawahar Knowledge Center) is a project of the Commissionerate of Higher Education, A.P to equip students with employability skills.

A Net work Resource Centre is established and functional. Students and staff utilize the facilities available.

6. Sri P.S.S.Sridhara Sarma, Lecturer in Physics has been working as placement officer. A campus drive was conducted on 30<sup>th</sup> Oct. 2013 by EBTS consultancy. A total of 107 students participated in it and 25 were selected, out of whom 6 were our college students. This campus drive offered positions as marketing executives and supervisors.

Another campus drive was recently conducted on 21<sup>st</sup> June 2014 through CEO (Center for Excellence in organization Pvt. Ltd) for Mondelez India Foods Pvt. Ltd( formerly Cadbury India). 39 students attended the drive, out of whom 23 were shortlisted for interview. 9 students were selected.

Recently DRDA ( District Rural Development Authority) has procured students data from the college and we hope more students will be employed.

Efforts are on to invite more recruitment agencies and see that the students get better placement opportunities.

A career guidance cell is established and has functional. Presently, Sri V. Madhusudana Rao, Associate Professor in Physics is working as the convener of the career guidance cell.

7. All the staff members are encouraged to apply for funding to conduct academic seminars/workshops/symposia on different levels.

Department of Zoology organized a 'National Seminar on Trends in Hospital Waste Management – Need of the Hour' on 8<sup>th</sup> & 9<sup>th</sup> Oct. 2012. This event was unded by UGC-SERO.

Department of Telugu is going to organize a 'National Seminar on Telugu Folk Literature – A Need to Study' on 20<sup>th</sup> & 21 August 2014.

Department of English submitted proposals and got approval from UGC-SERO to organize a National seminar on Student Centered Methodology in English Classroom at Undergraduate Level.

Other staff members are being encouraged to submit proposals.

8. Certificate course in Tourism and Travel Management was run during the academic years 2009-10, 2010-11, and 2011-12. Diploma in Toruissm and Travel Management was offered during the academic years 2010-11 and 2011-12.

Proposals for permission to start other career oriented certificate and diploma courses to the Registrar, Vikrama Simhapuri university for onward submission to University Grants Commission.

9. At present, Students Managed Hostel is available. During the last academic year 2013-14, students were given accommodation in one of the college buildings. Proposals for building hostel blocks were submitted to the University Grants Commission under Babu Jagjivan Ram Chaatraawaas Yojana Scheme. Also, proposals were submitted for construction of hostel buildings under Rashtriya Uchatara Siksha Abhayan Scheme.

10. At present canteen facility is not available because of low student strength.

11. Cooperative store is also not available, keeping in view the low student strength.

12. Office automation is in progress. Office is now equipped with desktop computers, scanners and reprographic machinery. All the recent files are being digitalized. Efforts are started to save old files in digital format.

- 13. Academic audit has been introduced during the academic year 2011-12 by the Commissionerate of Collegiate Education, A.P., Hyderabad. Nominees from o/o the Commissioner, Commissionerate of Collegiate Education, Andhra Pradesh visit our college during each academic year, audit the academic work and submit report to the Commissioner. In turn, an Action Taken Report (ATR) is submitted by the Principal after each visit by such academic audit teams.  
All the staff members are informed of the academic audit team remarks and report so that they can improve the functioning of teaching-learning process.**
- 14. Proposals for construction of compound wall are being submitted from time to time to the respective authorities. At present college has compound wall on the eastern side only.**
- 15. Proposals for construction of gymnasium and separate building for physical education department are being prepared to submit to UGC-SERO.**
- 16. As majority of the students admitted into the college are from Telugu medium background, Telugu medium courses are being run. Self financed course are run in English medium.**
- 17. As transfers are taken up by the Government of Andhra Pradesh, College has very little scope to retain staff permanently. But, only 20% of the staff members are allowed to get transferred at the beginning of an academic year.**
- 18. To improve admissions, a rigorous campaign is undertaken at the beginning of academic year. Information regarding the courses and curriculum is being transmitted by way of distribution of pamphlets, erection of flexis, advertisements in local channels etc.**
- 19. As a best practice college assembly is started with an intention to inculcate discipline, punctuality and improve the moral values among students.  
Special coaching is given for students who aspire for higher education.  
Students are given special rewards by the staff members for outstanding performance.  
Local philanthropists render financial help for poor students each academic year,**
- 20. Value education and professional ethics course is started from the academic year 2013-14, with an intention to improve personality of the students.**
